



YEAR 4 2024 College-Owned Student Device Agreement

Dear Families,

The use of technology in the classroom is an essential component of a well-rounded, holistic education for our students. The recent, rapid evolution of technology has brought about significant changes in the way teachers and students' access and use technology. To reflect these changes, the College is transitioning to a sustainable and future-proof model for educational technology. This move will better align our use of technology with the teaching and learning program and the education of our students.

Commencing in 2024, the College will begin the transition to a College-owned Device Program and all Year 4 students will be provided with a College-owned iPad to support their learning.

Some of the benefits of the College-Owned Student Device Program in 2024 include:

- Reduced instances of damaged, faulty, and misconfigured devices in the classroom
- All device purchasing, management, security, hardware and software is managed through the College
- The availability of replacement devices for legitimate warranty-related issues
- Less off-task use of technology in the classroom

A cost of \$340 Per Annum will be represented in College fees for Year 4 families, which includes:

- The iPad device
- Device management and security
- Comprehensive warranty
- Protective hard case
- Service and support
- Device swap out and replacement
- Software and licensing
